The **Roswell UFO Incident** was the alleged recovery of debris, including bodies, from a crashed object near Roswell, New Mexico on July 8th 1947. Many people witnessed the plummeting of the unusual craft on a stormy night in early July (given dates actually vary according to witnesses). 10 Tips for Perfect Fall Hair

Fall is a wonderful time of year. The leaves are changing color and the temperature is dropping. It is, however, a difficult time for us young girls to get our hair in fashion. Here are 10 style tips for fall:

1. Boost the body of your hair at the roots by scrunching in a curl gel and then flipping your head over and blasting the strands with a diffuser for a few minutes.
2. Sweep your bangs or your shortest layer of hair across your forehead for a dramatic effect.
3. Get messy texture on any hair type with a quarter size drop of texturizing gel. Apply to damp strands and air dry.
4. Use a one-inch curling iron to make ringlets in your hair. Brush the curls out to give them a rougher look.
5. For waves that tend to go flat, apply a curl defining mousse through your wet hair to lock in the style all day.
6. Give straight hair an edge by squirting spray wax on dry hair and rolling it into a high bun overnight.
7. Divide your hair into pieces by squirting a spray gel all over your head. Next, twist small selections around your fingers. Hold for a few seconds and then release for a cool kink.
8. Rub a tiny bit of pomade into your fingers and then twist small selections to emphasize a choppy cut.
9. Get sleek straight bangs by running a tiny flat iron over them from the roots to the ends.
