Veggie Lasagna: *a recipe by Lisa Ellis*

In a large skillet on medium heat, add 3-4 tbs. of Extra Virgin Olive Oil. Sauté until tender:

- 1 medium onion (chopped)
- 4 cloves of garlic (minced)
- 1 red pepper (chopped)
- 3 carrots & 3 mushrooms (chopped)
- ½ Small bunch of Broccoli (chopped)
- 1 small zucchini (chopped)

In a saucepot on medium heat, add 1 stick of butter, ¼ cup of flour, 2 cups of half and half until thickened. Add 1-½ cups of parmesan cheese and 1 package of cream cheese until combined.

Layer sauce, noodle and veggies. Repeat until all ingredients are used. Add mozzarella on the top layer. Cook approximately 45 minutes on 350 degrees.
